

# How to download course maps

## Printed/paper/picture of Course Maps (no navigation)

You can print a copy of the map of your course to carry with you during the race by navigating to one of the URLs below (13 Mile, 50 K or 50 M course), and while viewing or after downloading the .pdf file or the course, print it.

If your mobile device has a .pdf viewer, you can view the course map on your device during the race.

For just a picture of the course map to print or view on your mobile device, use a .pdf viewer/reader to export the map as an image. This is best done with a computer, then send the image to your mobile device.

## Geospatial PDF Course Maps for navigation

Geospatial course maps allow you to view your location on a PDF version of the course map on your mobile device without the need for a cellular/mobile data signal. We recommend installing the free [Avenza app \(iOS or Android\)](#) for viewing our geospatial PDF course maps. Once you have the Avenza app installed, download and add the geospatial PDF course map of your race below:

There are several ways to add one of the above maps in your Avenza app. Perhaps the easiest is to add via URL:

1. Install the Avenza PDF Maps app on your smartphone (available for iOS and Android).
2. Click the + button (top right) to add a map.
3. Click the "from URL" option (bottom).
4. Copy and paste or type in one of the URLs above (13 Mile, 50 K or 50 M course)

NOTE: It is not necessary to open the link in a web browser.

5. Wait for the map to download and process.
6. Open the map.
7. View your location on the map.

NOTE: Your device, and you, must be physically within the map area for your "dot" to show on the map.
